



INTERNAL RULES

In the interest of all our guests, we kindly ask you to observe the following points:

- 1) ANY PERSON WISHING TO ENTER OR STAY on the campsite must first report to the reception desk. Staying at the campsite implies acceptance of the provisions of these rules and the commitment to comply with them.
- 2) OUR CLIENTS SHALL AVOID ANY NOISE that may disturb their neighbours and silence is recommended from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- 3) Only vehicles belonging to the campers staying at the campsite may circulate in the campsite. Traffic in the campsite is limited to 10 km/h. The gates at the entrance are closed at midnight and no cars or motorbikes are allowed to enter the campsite from midnight to 6.00 am. Vehicles are then parked in the car park opposite the reception.
- 4) EVERYBODY MUST TAKE CARE of the good appearance of their installation and the cleanliness of their pitch. The pitch must be left clean on the day of your departure. Any action that could harm the cleanliness, hygiene and appearance of the campsite is forbidden. It is forbidden to add tents to the entire rental park. Household waste and paper must be put in rubbish bags and properly disposed of in the containers. Please make sure to respect the colours for selective sorting. Bulky objects must be crushed beforehand. Plantations must be respected. It is strictly forbidden to put nails in trees and to cut branches. It is forbidden to pull clotheslines in the entire rental park.
- 5) ACCOMPANY YOUR CHILDREN TO THE TOILETS AND MAKE THEM UNDERSTAND THAT THE TOILETS ARE NOT A PLAYGROUND OR AN ENTERTAINMENT AREA.
- 6) SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS: In case of flooding, follow the instructions. Consult the evacuation plan at the reception desk and on the toilet blocks (evacuation is primarily for people). A prefectural decree prohibits the use of charcoal barbecues on campsites. Only gas barbecues are allowed. Do not throw cigarettes or poorly extinguished matches on the ground. No electrical connections that do not comply with safety standards will be tolerated. The Management is in no way responsible for theft on the site. Please inform the reception immediately of the presence on the campsite of any person who seems suspicious. Although the campsite is guarded, the users of the campsite are invited to take all precautions to safeguard their equipment.

7) **DOGS ARE ALLOWED ON A LEAD.** They may not be left alone on the campsite, even if tied up, in the absence of their owners who are civilly responsible for them (identification by tattoo and valid anti-rabies vaccination). For the sake of the other campers, it is however compulsory to take them for regular walks outside the campsite or in the areas designated for this purpose. Dogs of the 1st and 2nd category are not allowed on the campsite.

8) **THERE IS ENOUGH WATER ON THE CAMPSITE:** nevertheless, we ask you not to waste it and not to use it for washing vehicles.

9) **OUR GUESTS RECEIVING GUESTS** during the day are required to report them to the reception. Their cars are not allowed to enter the campsite (visits are not allowed after 20.00). Day visitors are not allowed to enter the water park.

10) **THE SWIMMING POOL** is strictly reserved for the campsite's guests. We ask you to respect the hygiene and safety instructions posted at the entrance to the pool. Long swimming shorts, T-shirts and burkinis are not allowed in the pools.

11) **ALL GUESTS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR A TAMPER-PROOF WRISTBAND.** From the opening of the campsite.
